Dear Broadview Residents,

As your Mayor, I remain committed to keeping our residents informed about important projects and investments taking place throughout our community. Transparency, communication, and community engagement continue to be priorities as we work together to strengthen Broadview for today and future generations.

One of the most significant infrastructure projects currently underway is the Broadview Westchester Joint Water Agency Reservoir Project located near Legion Park. This project represents a major investment in safe drinking water, emergency preparedness, environmental sustainability, and long term infrastructure resiliency. As a land locked community, Broadview must continue making strategic investments that protect public health and support the future growth and sustainability of our village.

Conversations and planning regarding the reservoir project date back to 2021, demonstrating the Village's long term commitment to proactive infrastructure planning and regional water sustainability. The additional 1.5 million-gallon reservoir will increase our regional water storage capacity and help ensure reliable service during emergencies, peak demand periods, water main breaks, or other unexpected disruptions. Reliable water infrastructure is essential not only for residents, but also for our schools, businesses, healthcare facilities, and public safety operations.

In addition to the reservoir project, the Village will begin tree replacement and has already begun. Trees play an important role in neighborhood beautification, environmental sustainability, storm water management, and improving air quality throughout our community. We appreciate residents' patience and cooperation as this important work moves forward.

The Tree Keeper system allows residents to report concerns, review tree-related information, and stay connected regarding forestry maintenance and replacement activities throughout the Village.

Additionally, street replacement improvements are scheduled within impacted areas to address roadway conditions, improve drainage, and enhance overall neighborhood infrastructure. While construction activity may create temporary inconveniences, these investments are necessary to improve the long-term quality, safety, and sustainability of our community.

We understand projects of this magnitude naturally bring questions and concerns. Please know that your voice matters, and we remain committed to keeping residents informed every step of the way. Strong communities are built through communication, partnership, and shared responsibility.


