OPERATIONS SUMMARY

- During the month of April 2020, Members of the Broadview Police Department responded to 841 calls as compared to 1,325 calls in March 2020.
- 35 cases were assigned to the Detective Bureau; 15 cases were cleared/closed with 1 arrests being made resulting in a 42.86% solvability for the month. 17 previously assigned cases were also cleared/closed with no arrest being made.
- 139 total cases for the year have been assigned to the Detective Bureau; 102 were cleared /closed with 14 arrests being made resulting in a 73.38% solvability for the year.

Noteworthy Events:

Participated in the funeral services of two Police Officers, who passed as a result of CoVid-19 complications.

Participated in a Social Distanced Birthday Party Parade.

Donated unclaimed bicycles to local not-for-profits, for repair and distribution to those in need.

Command and Staff meeting concerning CoVid-19 and impact on the Village of Broadview, residents and employees.

Responded to twenty calls concerning social distancing and business operations.





The Index Crimes are used to indicate the amount and extent of serious crimes in a given jurisdiction as defined by the International Association of Chiefs of Police Committee on Uniform Crime Reports. Index Crimes include the following "Violent Crimes": murder, non-negligent manslaughter, aggravated criminal sexual assault, robbery, aggravated battery and aggravated assault. Also included are the following "Property Crimes": burglary, theft, larceny, motor vehicle theft and arson. The Crime Index is the total number of Index Offenses occurring within a given jurisdiction during a specified period of time. From May 2019 to April 2020, Broadview's Crime Index is 399. Compared to 323 for the period of May 2018 to April 2019. This is a 23.53% Increase from the previous year.

While we have seen an increase in the amount of reportable offenses, criminal arrests have also increased by 37.14%. From May 2019 to April 2020, a total of 144 arrests were made as compared to 105 for the period of May 2018 to April 2019.


The Broadview Police Department is constantly resolving its strategies in order to reduce crime with in the Village as well as to actively pursue offenders.













April 2020 Burglary Reports
