RE: Juneteenth Celebration 2026

On June 20th & June 21st, a special celebration will take place at Schroeder Park. The 6th Annual Juneteenth Celebration will feature history, entertainment, food and vendors!

The Juneteenth Celebration Committee would like to make you aware of the event, and inform you that approval was granted by the Village of Broadview to allow this event to take place.

Community Awareness: In order to provide the necessary safety precautions for the event, the following streets/avenues will be blocked off or have no entry:

- 14th Avenue/16th Street to 16th Avenue/16th Street
- The corner of 13th Avenue/15th Street to 17th Avenue/15th Street
- The Southeast corner of 13th Avenue & 18th Street will be blocked off
- There will be no entry onto the corner of 17th Avenue/16th Street going eastbound.
- The 2500 Block of 13th Avenue, 14th Avenue, 15th Avenue & 16th Avenue will be blocked. No parking in the street during event hours.

No entry will be permitted on:

- Friday, June 19, 2026 from 6 am – 10 pm – Installation of gates and Stage
- Saturday, June 20, 2026 from 6 am – 10 pm
- Sunday, June 21, 2026 from 6 am – 10 pm

NO PARKING ON 16TH AVE STARTING AT 6AM ON JUNE 19 -21.

It is with the safety of the community in mind that we must close off the streets/avenues. We apologize in advance if this causes any inconvenience. If you need access to your vehicle that is usually parked in a garage or driveway facing 16th Street, please remove by Friday, June 19th before 6 am. Set-up will take place during this time.

Event Operating Hours: Entertainment and Activities will take place on:

- June 20, 2026 from 3pm to 10 pm –Celebrating 100 years of Black Excellence
- June 21, 2026 from 3pm to 9:30 pm –Celebrating Father's Day & Fireworks
- **ALL Youth 17yrs & under MUST be accompanied by an adult at 6pm to enter**

Music will be presented from the main stage in two-hour intervals with thirty-minute breaks between performances. There will be a DJ as well as live band performances.

Parking for the Public: Free parking will be available on the west side of the Target Store located in Broadview Village Square, Elkay on 17th and Raincoat.
