### OVERNIGHT PARKING PERMITS AVAILABLE NOW

The Village of Broadview has enacted an ordinance that affects those who wish to park their vehicles on the street overnight. As in the past, street parking within the village from 2-5am is prohibited, with up to four (4) exceptions made per month at the discretion of the Chief of Police.

This new ordinance seeks to provide an alternative for residents who desire to park on the street more than 4 times a month, by identifying specific zones within the village and issuing monthly parking permits for spaces within those zones.

Six (6) zones have been identified, and signage has been erected. Those who do not possess a permit will be prohibited from parking in these zones.

Permits are available for purchase at the Village hall (Broadview Fire Department during construction). Upon purchase, you will receive a rear-view mirror hanging placard and a replaceable monthly sticker. **The monthly cost is:** \$ 30.00

#### Frequently asked questions:

# Q. If I pay for an overnight parking permit, does that mean that I can park in these designated zones even if 2 inches of snow is expected?

A. No. The village's Snow Ban on street parking supersedes the permit program. Even if you have purchased an overnight parking permit, you must make other parking arrangements as these zones will be plowed just like any other street and they must be clear in order to plow.

# Q. What if I have relatives staying the night? Do I need to purchase a monthly parking permit?

A. You can call the Police Department (708 345-6550), and may be granted emergency overnight parking permission up to four (4) times per month without an overnight parking permit.

#### Q. If I purchase a monthly parking permit, can I park on any street?

A. No. You must park in a designated zone (see map for zone assignments).

#### Q. Must I purchase a separate overnight parking permit for every car I own?

A. No. However, the permit must be properly displayed and clearly visible in the parked car.

# Q. With an overnight parking permit, what hours am I allowed to have my car in the designated zone?

A. 10pm-6am


#### Q. Can I purchase more than one month at a time?

A. Yes.

# Q. If I purchase an overnight parking permit in the middle of the month, will the cost be pro-rated?

A. No.

### 7-4-2-2: OVERNIGHT PARKING PERMITS

- A. Overnight Parking Permitted. Overnight parking shall be permitted in certain designated areas as provided for herein and under the conditions stated herein provided that a permit for such parking is obtained from the Village, as set forth in this subsection.
- B. Zoned Permit Parking. Designated permit parking areas shall be divided into parking zones ("Zone(s)") and any person possessing a permit for a specific Zone may park in any designated permit parking areas with the same Zone number. Parking in the wrong Zone is a violation of this ordinance. The parking Zones shall include the following locations:
  - 1. Zone 1 vehicles under 8,000 pounds only
    - i. 25<sup>th</sup> Avenue between Harvard Street and Fillmore Street (2000 block of 25<sup>th</sup> Avenue), west side of street; and
    - ii. 24th Avenue north of Roosevelt Road to the alley, east and west sides of street; and
    - 24<sup>th</sup> Avenue south of Roosevelt Road to the alley, east and west sides of street; and
    - iv. 23<sup>rd</sup> Avenue north of Roosevelt Road to the alley, east and west sides of street; and
    - v. 23<sup>rd</sup> Avenue south of Roosevelt Road to the alley, east and west sides of street; and
    - vi. 21st Avenue north of Roosevelt Road to the alley, east and west sides of street; and
    - vii. 21st Avenue south of Roosevelt Road to the alley, east and west sides of street.

### 2. Zone 2 vehicles under 8,000 pounds only

- i. 1600 block of Lexington Street between 17th Avenue and the alley on the east, north side of street:
- 3. Zone 3 vehicles under 8,000 pounds only unless otherwise provided herein.
  - i. 13th Avenue north of Roosevelt Road to the alley, west side of street:
  - 13<sup>th</sup> Avenue south of Roosevelt Road to the alley, east and west sides of street; and
  - iii. 11<sup>th</sup> Avenue south of Roosevelt Road to the alley, east and west sides of street.
    - 1. Persons parking a semi-truck or trailer must call the Broadview Police Department prior to parking in said Zone 3 lot to ensure availability.
- 4. Zone 4 vehicles under 8,000 pounds only:
  - i. 18th Street between 10th Avenue and 12th Avenue, south side of street.
- 5. Zone 5 vehicles under 8,000 pounds only
  - i. 9<sup>th</sup> Avenue between 19<sup>th</sup> Street and Cermak Road (2800 and 2900 block of 9<sup>th</sup> Avenue), east side of street.
- 6. Zone 6 vehicles under 8,000 pounds only
  - i. 16th Avenue and Roosevelt Road at the Village-owned lot
