Back Flow Survey Introduction Letter

To All Property Owners and Managers:

The Village of Broadview is currently conducting a Backflow Prevention Survey to protect the Municipal water supply and the water used by our residents, businesses and visitors. We are conducting this survey to fulfill requirements set forth by the Illinois Pollution Control Board Regulations, 35 Ill, Adm Code 607.104. Pursuant to this regulation, Broadview has had to adopt a Backflow Ordinance CO-10-31.

The attached survey must be completed, and it must include the number of fixtures, and the type of fixtures or appliances that are connected to your water system. After the form is completed and returned, an Inspector from the Village of Broadview will perform an inspection verifying the type and number of device(s). As the program progresses a Village Inspector will be scheduled to perform a test on these devices. This will help to insure that the water system is completely protected.

If you fail to provide the information required by the survey, in 10 days, we will hand deliver a second notice that will need to be completed and returned in 7 days. In the event that it is not returned after the 8th day of the second notice, we will disconnect water service until compliance with the survey is achieved. In addition, the failure to submit a completed survey will be considered a violation of this Village ordinance and you will be subjected to the fines set forth in the Schedule of Fines and Fees (please find enclosed).

The Inspection will consist of a physical site inspection and testing of the device(s). If a device passes the inspection then it will begin the process of annual testing; should the device fail inspection there will be interruption of or your water service with or without notice.

Thank you in advance for your cooperation and immediate attention to this matter.

- Provide a reduced pressure backflow preventer (RPZ) on the makeup water supply line to the _____.
- Provide a RPDA _____ on the domestic (potable) water supply to the fire protection system. Provide the results of an Available Pressure Verification Test to substantiate pressure and volume for the proper operation of the fire protection system.
- Provide an RPZ on the makeup water supply to the cooling tower.
