OPERATIONS SUMMARY

- During the month of August 2022 Members of the Broadview Police Department responded to 1436 calls as compared to 1557 calls in July.
- IKE 911 Communications Center received 3363 calls for service for Broadview & Maywood compared to 3623 calls for service in July.
- The Detective Bureau assigned 63 new cases. One case was cleared by arrest. Eighteen older cases were cleared with no arrests.

National Night Out was a complete success! Kids received a book bag with pencils, crayons, a notebook and folder for “back to school”.

Lindop & Roosevelt School started classes for the 2022-2023 school year.
